

On March 9, 2009, the King County Council passed Ordinance 16379, which directed the Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD) to identify locations for the stockpiling of sand and sandbags to be provided to the public free of charge during flood events. Local jurisdictions or community groups will oversee sandbag distribution, and WLRD will coordinate delivery of materials.

King County WLRD currently owns approximately 123,000 bags. The Corps of Engineers is providing 100,000 bags—to be stored at Wastewater’s South Treatment Plant in Renton—and 23,000 bags previously purchased by WLRD are stored at the Roads Shop in Renton. Once this supply is exhausted, WLRD will use private vendors to deliver bags. The following tables present confirmed and possible partners in the sandbag program, along with expected *initial* delivery needs. As jurisdictions begin to deplete their initial supply of sandbags, WLRD will need support delivering additional bags (until the supply of 123,000 is completely distributed). The extent of this additional need will be determined by the severity and extent of flooding. *All sand will be delivered by private vendors.*
